
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CONNECTION TO THE TAP

UNSCREW EXTERNAL RING NUT ${\bf C}$ AND TIGHTEN 3/4" FEMALE CONNECTOR ${\bf A}$ On the 3/4" TAB ${\bf B}$. FIX the timer to the tap by tightening ring nut ${\bf C}$.



WATER PRESSURE TABLE

BAR 0,5 1 2 2,5 3 4 5 1/min 11 16 22 25 27 31 35

VOLTAGE -POWER TABLE 1 × 9 VOLT ALKALINE BATTERY.

DURATION: THIS BATTERY IS SUFFICIENT TO POWER THE TIMER FOR AN ENTIRE SEASON WITH AN AVERAGE OF 2 DAILY WATERING CYCLES. TO PREVENT THE RISK OF CORROSION CAUSED BY ACID, REMOVE THE BATTERY FROM THE TIMER DURING PERIODS OF THE INACTIVITY. WHEN THE CHARGE IS TOO LOW, THE TIMER AUTOMATICALLY INTERRUPTS OPERATION BY CLOSING THE SOLENOID VALVE.

BATTERY CHARGE CONTROL

THE TIMER AUTOMATICALLY REGULATES THE BATTERY CHARGE STATUS. THE UNIT COMES COMPLETE WITH POLARITY INVERSION PROTECTION AND THE BATTERY STATUS INDICATOR. THE BATTERY IS FULLY CHARGED WHEN THE MESSAGE IMBIGATED IS MITTING.



KEY PAD

THREE BUTTONS ARE USED TO PROGRAM ALL THE PARAMETERS. USING THESE BUTTONS YOU CAN SELECT THE VARIOUS OPERATION MODES AND CHANGE THE CURRENT TIME SETTING, WATERING CYCLES AND DAYS.

EACH TIME YOU PRESS ONE OF THE BUTTONS A BEEP CONFIRMS THE COMMAND GIVEN.







THE DISPLAY



FITTING THE BATTERY

USING THE TWO SIDE BUTTONS ON THE FRONT PANEL, SIMPLY DISCONNECT AND PRESS-FIT THE BATTERY TERMINALS. MAKE SURE THAT THE BATTERY IS CORRECTLY POSITIONED IN ITS HOUSING.

REPLACE THE BATTERY WITHIN 15 MINUTES TO AVOID LOSING THE SET PROGRAMS







SETTING THE CURRENT TIME

AS SOON AS THE BATTERY HAS BEEN CONNECTED ALL THE DISPLY SECTIONS SWITCH ON. THE VALVE OPENS FOR 2 SECONDS AND THE TIMER SETS TO 00:00



BY PRESSING THE CENTRAL BUTTON THE MESSAGE OK IS DISPLAYED. PRESS OF TO INCREASE OR DECREASE THE TIME SETTING ACCORDINGLY. FOR RAPID MOVING, SIMPLY HOLD THE RELATIVE BUTTON PRESSED DOWN UNTIL YOU REACH THE TIME SETTING REQUIRED. TO EXIT FROM THIS PAGE, PRESS .

PROGRAMMING

THE PROGRAM COMPRISES A NUMBER OF PAGES, EACH OF WHICH CONTAINS TWO FUNCTIONS:

- PROGRAM DISPLAY
 PROGRAM MODIFICATION
- PRESS TO MOVE FORWARDS THROUGH THE PROGRAMS.

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ATTENTION: IF, WHEN OPENING THE FIRST PROGRAM (OPEN) YOU HAVE WRONLGY PUSHED TWICE, THE NUMBER OF THE PROGRAM (1) WILL BE DISPLAYED WITH RUN TIME FROM 00:00 TO 00:01. TO RE-SET THE FIRST PROGRAM YOU HAVE TO CANCEL THE ONE WRONGLY SET (PAGE 14)




WATERING PROGRAM 1 IS SET TO START (OPEN) AT 10:26 AND END (CLOSED) AT 10:35 $\,$









WATERING PROGRAM 2 IS SET TO START AT 10:40 AND END (CLOSED) AT 10:50
BY MOVING WITH ▶ YOU CAN SET THE OTHER PROGRAMS IN THE SAME WAY.
PRESS ◀ TO RETURN TO TIME-SETTING MODE.
MOVE WITH ▶ TO ACCESS WEEKLY WATERING MODE.

WEELKY PROGRAMMING





WARNING: DAY (1) IS THE FIRST DAY THE FIRST PROGRAM IS SET. EXAMPLE: THE FIRST PROGRAM WAS SET ON THURSDAY — DAY (1) = THURSDAY (AS DISPLAYED ON THE CURRENT TIME PAGE).

WARNING: DAY (1) IS A REFERENCE FOR THE WEEKLY PROGRAM MANAGEMENT.

EXAMPLE: IF DAY (1) = THURSDAY AND YOU DO NOT WISH TO RUN A WATERING CYCLE ON FRIDAYS, ELMINATE DAY (2)

PRESS ON TO MOVE THE CURSOR TO THE NUMBER OF THE DAY YOU WISH TO OMIT AND PRESS TO DELETE SAID DAY. TO EXIT FROM THIS PAGE, POSITION THE CURSOR UNDER EXIT AND CONFIRM WITH ATTER EXITING THE WEEKLY WATERING CYCLE PAGE. PRESS

TO DISPLAY MANUAL FUNCTION MODE.





TO DELETE A PROGRAM USE THE ► KEY TO MOVE FORWARDS UNTIL YOU REACH THE PROGRAM TO BE CANCELLED. THE DELETION PHASE (CLOSED) IS THEN ENTERED BY PRESSING ● TO DELETE THE PROGRAM, SIMULTANEOUSLY PRESS BUTTON ● AND ►, TAKING CARE TO PRESS THE ● BUTTON SLIGHTLY IN ADVANCE.

EACH TIME YOU PRESS TO ACCESS A PROGRAM AND DO NOT MODIFY ITS DATA WITHIN 10 SECONDS, THE PROGRAM EMITS AN ACOUSTIC SIGNAL AND

INSTRUCTIONS

- DO NOT ALLOW THE APLIANCE TO FREEZE OVER.
- DO NOT USE AQUAUNO VIDEO ON HOSES CONTAINING CHEMICAL SUBSTANCES OR ANY LIQUID OTHER THAN WATER
- DO NOT USE HEAVY OBJECTS TO PRESS THE BUTTONS WHICH HAVE BEEN SPECIALLY DESIGNED TO RESPOND TO THE TOUCH OF A FINGER
- DO NOT OPERATE AQUAUNO VIDEO WHEN INLET PRESSURE EXCEEDING 10 BAR.
- ONLY USE NEW BATTERIES AND DULY REPLACE WHEN INDICATED BY THE DISPLAY.
- WHEN NOT PROGRAMMING, KEEP THE COVER CLOSED TO PROTECT THE DISPLAY FROM EXPOSURE TO SUNLIGHT AND HUMIDITY.
- AT LEAST ONCE A SEASON, CLEAN THE SINTHETIC FOAM FILTER UNDER RUNNING WATER. IN THE CASE OF HARD OR RAIN WATER, THE FILTER MUST BE CLEANED MORE FREQUENTLY.



CONNECTING TO A RAIN SENSOR

THE AQUAUNO VIDEO CAN BE CONNECTED TO A RAIN SENSOR (CLABER CODE 90915). THE RAIN SENSOR CUTS OFF THE AQUAUNO VIDEO WATERING PROGRAM IN CASE OF RAIN, RESTORING IT AUTOMATICALLY WHEN THERE IS NO MORE WATER LEFT IN THE SENSOR.

THE RAIN SENSOR MUST BE CONNECTED TO THE TWO SPECIAL ELECTRICAL CONTACTS PROVIDE INSIDE THE AQUAUNO VIDEO PROGRAMMING MODULE, USING THE CONNECTOR SUPPLIED WITH THE SENSOR. THE TWO-WIRE CABLE MUST BE FED IN THROUGH THE SEAT PROVIDED IN THE BOTTOM OF THE AQUAUNO VIDEO. BEFORE FITTING THE CONNECTOR, REMOVE THE JUMPER PLACED OVER THE TWO CONTACTS. FOR THE CONNECTION DIAGRAM, SEE RIGHT.
